The Animal Control Officer is to enforce animal laws established by the state. To respond to complaints by the public and handle nuisance animals. Officer must control, contain and transport animals. Must have knowledge of humane animal care and control measures.

- Current valid Alabama State Driver's License
- Clear background check and safe driving check
- Reached a minimum of 21 years of age
- Ability to acquire certifications and license as required
- Able to be on call 24/7
- Must be able to travel overnight to attend meeting and training programs
- Must be able to communicate effectively using written and oral methods; ability to write legibly
- Must be able to lift animals and items weighing in excess of 50 lbs.
- One year experience with animals, Sheriff's Office and general public is preferred.
