Lawrence County Solid Waste Director Position

Job Requirements: This position is responsible for directing the Lawrence County Solid Waste Department and all related programs. Performs professional and technical administrative work, managing a solid waste system including collection, disposal and recycling operations. Leading, planning, directing, coordinating and supervising all areas of development & implementation related to solid waste operations. Ability to direct supervision of department staff. Experienced & strong management skills are a must. Knowledge of the principles and practices of personnel and labor relations administration. Experience of accounting related processes, budgeting processes, procurements processes, and ability to develop and administer a budget. Ability to prepare and monitor department budget, review and approve department budget requests, and determines budget related priorities. Strong communications skills are a must. Willing to work overtime and weekends in emergencies. Willing to travel to training & conferences.

Knowledge Requirements: Any combination of education and/or experience equivalent to graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration, Public Administration, or Environmental Science and/or at least 5 years of cumulative experience in Solid Waste operations, and/or experience in managing complex organizations, systems, finance and employees. Must possess a valid Alabama Driver's License, with the ability to obtain an Alabama Class B Commercial Driver's License (CDL) or Class A CDL, if needed.
